Afternoon Activities

Several afternoon activities are being planned for the camporee, including amateur radio demonstration, rifle and shotgun shooting, model rocket launching, and a CPR skills site. Some require special attention prior to arriving at the camporee:

- Scouts and Scouters interested in launching a model rocket should bring a rocket, motors and other necessary equipment.
- Shooting sports will require an addition cost. In addition, Scouts and Scouters desiring to participate in rifle & shotgun shooting **must complete** a Hold Harmless Agreement (adults) or Release for Students (youth) and bring it to the range on the day of the event and turn it in to the Rangemaster at check-in. **Nobody** will be permitted to remain on the range premises unless they turn in a properly signed applicable form.
- CPR Skills - to pass off some of the boys requirements. Demonstrate skills required for advancement (limited to first 20 Scouts who arrive).
- Amateur Radio demonstration.

Talakto District Spring 2008 CAMPOREE Events

1. **First-Aid obstacle course** - Patrols would be drilled on what to do in a given situation, maybe four or five scenarios. Speed and accuracy would be factored. Time limit event.
2. **Orienteering course** - Patrols would be measuring how close they got to a particular object using a compass.
3. **Name the Merit Badge** - Pictures of many of the 100+ merit badges are shown and the patrols identify them. Number of correct identifications within time limit.
4. **Blind-folded Tent set-up** - Patrols will either be silenced or blindfolded while the PL guides them through setting up a tent. Leadership, Teamwork, and Accuracy graded. Time limit event. Note: patrol must furnish their own tent.
5. **Back pack relay** - Properly loading a backpack, doing a relay, and unpacking, timed event for the patrol. Patrol will furnish backpack, standard load (provided at station) will be used for all patrols. Timed event
6. **Knot Relay** – Scouts will move forward, identify knot, tie knot, and return to allow next Scout to do the next knot. Timed event.
7. **Leave No Trace Station** – Scouts will be presented a sample campsite and will identify Leave No Trace “violations”. Timed event
