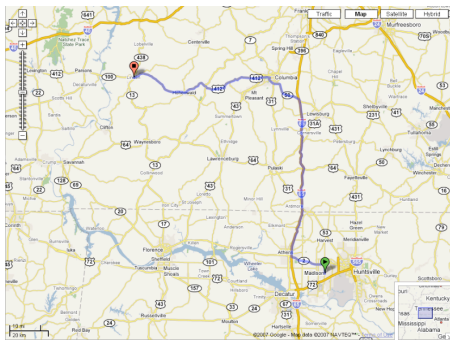


# GRIMES CANOE BASE

## July 13 – 17, 2008



The Buffalo River is a Class I and II river located approximately 1.5 hours southwest of Nashville, TN (~ 3 hours NW of Madison). Troop 350's **2008 canoe** trip will involve a 50-mile canoe trip centered around the Grimes Canoe Base (owned & maintained by the Middle Tennessee Council and operated by Wayne Hamm).

### Fees Per Person (two per canoe):

Canoe and Paddling Gear Rental:	\$ 40
Tent Rental: Sun and Mon at GCB	\$ 6
Transportation:	\$ 10
Food:	\$ 50
<b>Total (Estimate per person)</b>	<b>\$106</b>

### Trip schedule:

- July 13th – Leave St. Johns at Noon; camp overnight at GCB
- July 14th – Leave gear behind and paddle 15 mi. downriver; camp at GCB
- July 15th – Shuttle 35 miles upstream w/ gear and start paddling (~15 mi.); camp on river
- July 16th – Keep paddling (~15 mi.); camp on river
- July 17th – Keep paddling (~5 mi.); Arrive GCB at 1300, Pack up leave GCB at 1400; arrive at St. Johns 1730

*Note: a 10 hour service project is required to receive the 50 mile Patch.*

### What to Bring:

Swimming Suit, Camping Gear, Snacks, Dry Bags (S, M, L), Scout Book, Water Bottles, Sponge (Big), Tents, Water Shoes, Stoves, Sunscreen, Hat, Sun Glasses
