New Leader Essentials 8:00 AM – 9:30 AM

New Leader Essentials is the initial training for all adult Scout Leaders serving youth in the Boy Scouts of America. Through a series of lively presentations, this 90-minute training presents an overview of the core elements of Scouting. If you have previously attended the New Leader Essentials, you do not have to take the course again, even if you have a different position in Scouting, but please arrive by 9:30 as we start the specific training as soon as the essentials are complete.

Cub Scout Leader Specific Training 10:00 AM – 1:00 PM

All Cub Scout leaders are considered trained when they have completed New Leader Essentials and the Cub Scout Leader Specific training for their position. All leader specific modules will include 3 sessions: Organization, Advancement, and Program Planning. Leaders should attend the module for their specific Cub Scout position. Training for the following positions is offered:

Tiger Cub Leaders

Cub Scout Den Leaders

Webelos Den Leaders

Cubmaster and Assistant Cubmaster

Pack Committee Members

Den Chief Training 8:00 AM – 12:00 Noon

This is a training course for Boy Scouts who are or who want to be Den Chiefs. The course covers the role and responsibilities of a Den Chief, the structure of a den meeting, and den activities.

BSA Troop Committee Challenge Training 10:00 AM – 1:00 PM

Troop Committee Training is for troop committee members, although parents and other troop leaders are invited to attend. Learn about the responsibilities of a troop committee, how the committee should be organized, and the positions to be filled on the committee.

BSA Scoutmaster / Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training 10:00 AM - 5:30 PM

This is the initial training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters (and other interested persons). This course covers the essentials of their leadership positions and provides information to help them become successful Scout leaders. Learn about working with the boys, troop organization, the patrol method, the outdoor program, the advancement program, and program planning. To be fully trained, Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training. The next course will be conducted at Camp Jackson in Scottsboro on October 27 – 29.

Merit Badge Counselor Training 1:00 PM – 2:00 PM

Learn all about being a merit badge counselor, from getting registered to how the merit badge process works. No charge if you only take this course. This course is a one-time requirement for all Merit Badge Counselors.

Varsity Coach Leader Specific Training 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM

This is the basic training for Varsity Coaches and Assistant Coaches. To become fully trained, these leaders must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training.

Venture Leader Specific Training 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM

Provides the necessary and sufficient knowledge and skills a new Venturing Advisor or assistant Advisor needs to operate a Venturing crew. Venturing Crew Advisors, Assistant Advisors, and Crew Committee Members are considered trained when they have completed New Leader Essentials and Venturing Leader Specific Training.
