Itinerary

Friday, 24 April

Saturday, 25 April

Events – Eight (8) events and activities will be provided Saturday morning through Saturday afternoon culminating in closing ceremonies at 5:00 PM. All patrols will be assigned a start event. A "Shotgun Start" will occur at 9:00 AM Saturday. All events will be conducted in patrol groups. Each Patrol Leader will be responsible for leading his patrol through all stations. Patrols with less than 5 (members + guests) will need to guest up with another patrol (no larger than 9 scouts total per patrol).

Timed and scored events

1. **Cooking** – Relay race in which scouts will cook and consume an abbreviated breakfast. Each patrol must bring their own skillet.
2. **Fire Building** – Scouts will be required to build a fire and burn a string above the fire. Each patrol must bring their own kindling and wood; no accelerants allowed.
3. **Measurements** – Scouts will have to determine the height, or width of a specified object using the methods supplied.
4. **Lashing** – Scouts will be required to construct a transport mechanism to carry fellow patrol members around a course.
5. **First Aid** - Scouts will use various First Aid techniques to transport fellow members out of danger.
6. **Water Rescue** – Scouts will save a "drowning" victim (on dry land!).
7. **Camping** – Scouts will use supplied materials to properly construct a dining fly.
8. **Orienteering** – Scouts will have to find their bearings on this compass course.
