Scout Trailer Towing CHECKLIST

- 1. Inflate trailer tires to **50** psi.
- 2. Verify Tow Vehicle and hitch is capable of towing 3,000 pounds. Verify Tow Vehicle's hitch has a 2 inch ball.
- 3. Lower Trailer onto ball using trailer jack and latch the Handle Assembly in the down position.



- 4. Secure Handle Assembly in the down position using the padlock.
- 5. Use the trailer jack to attempt to lift the Trailer off the ball to verify a secure connection. The jack should lift both the trailer and tow vehicle slightly.
- 6. Raise Trailer Jack completely to provide ground clearance for towing.
- 7. Secure Safety Chains. The chains should cross (X) each other under the assembly and attach to the tow vehicle's hitch.
- 8. Make electrical connection for trailer lights. Verify trailer lights operate.
- 9. Load trailer.
 - a. Bulk of the weight should be between the trailer axle and the tow vehicle.
 - b. Lighter weight items can be packed between the axle and the trailer doors.
